



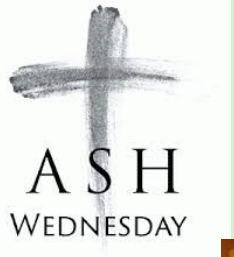

Literacy

Reading: Children will be reading individual letters by saying the sound for them. They will blend these sounds into words reading short words

Writing: Spelling words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sound with letters.

Numeracy

Subitising: Recognising the number of objects up to 5 without needing to count them. Recognising patterns within these numbers and using a tens frame to support this.

Patterns: Continue, copy and create repeating patterns
