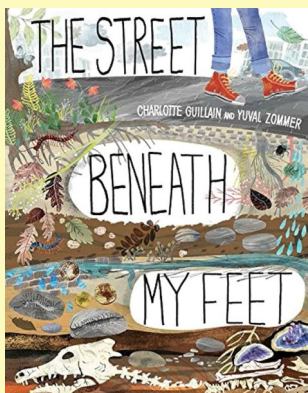

*Non-Fiction Unit: Explanation Text*

This informative book takes you on a fascinating journey down through the layers of the Earth, all the way to the planet's core and out the other side. When you're out walking around, whether on the city streets or a country trail, there's always so much to see and hear. The children will use the information from this to write an explanation text about creepy crawly insects that lurk beneath our feet.

**Skills:** prepositions, inverted commas, commas for lists, singular possession, a/an rule, adverbs, pronouns. **Spelling Focus:** homophones, adding the prefix: bi-, re-, words ending with 'gue', /sh/ sounds spelt with 'ch'.

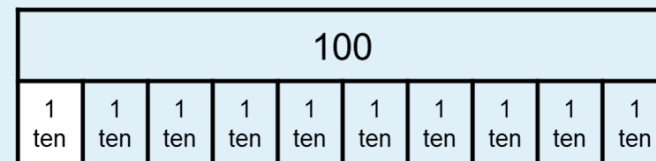

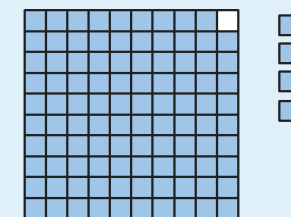
## Bridging 100:

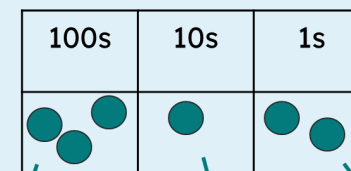
