Every child in school has written a Lenten Promise for Lent based on:



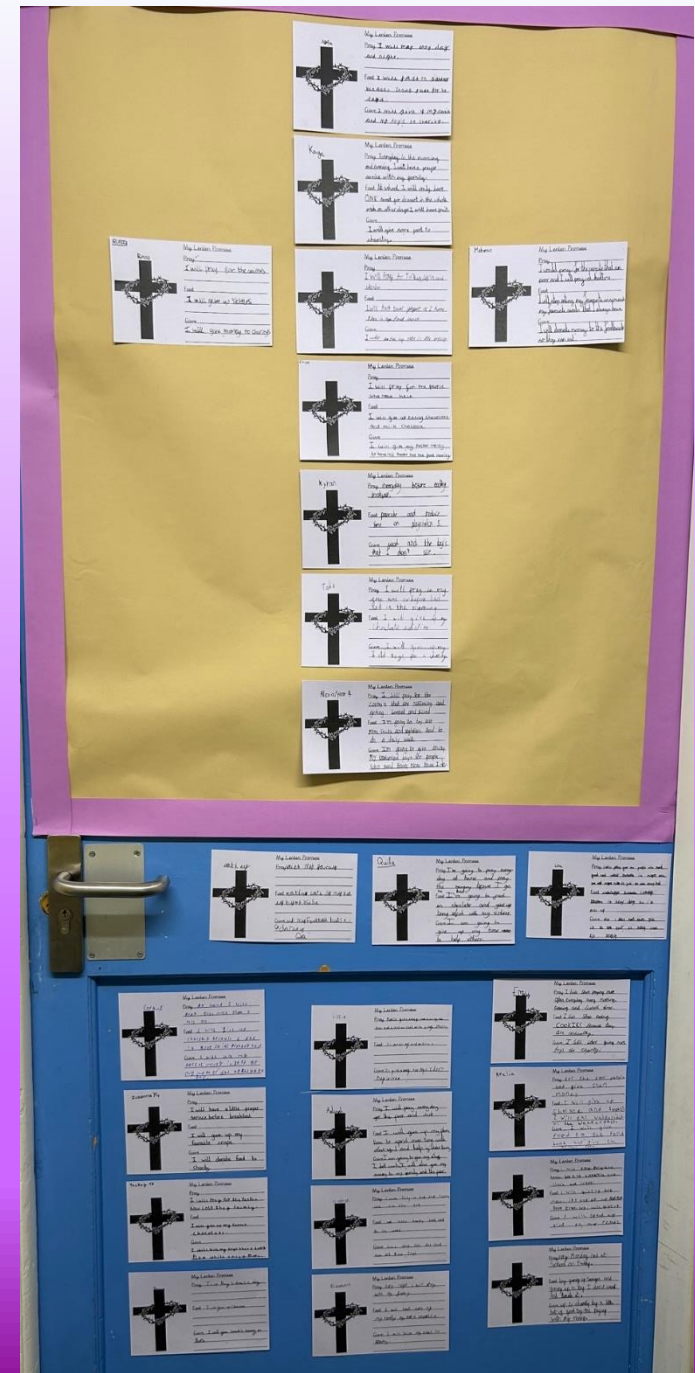
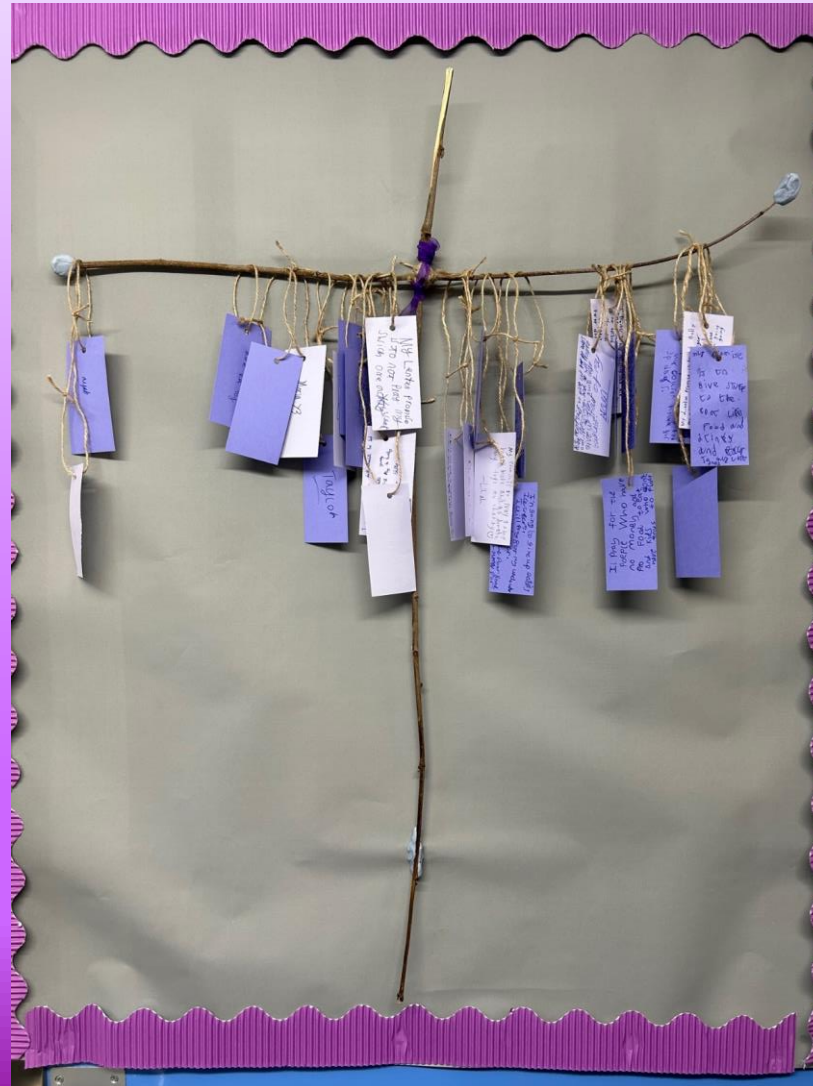
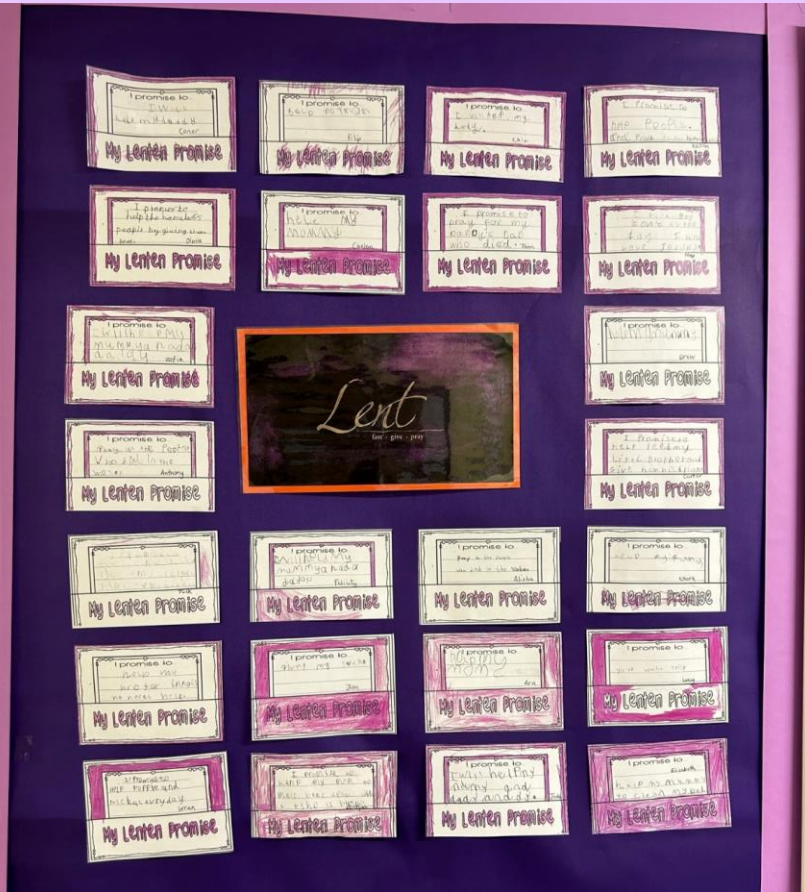

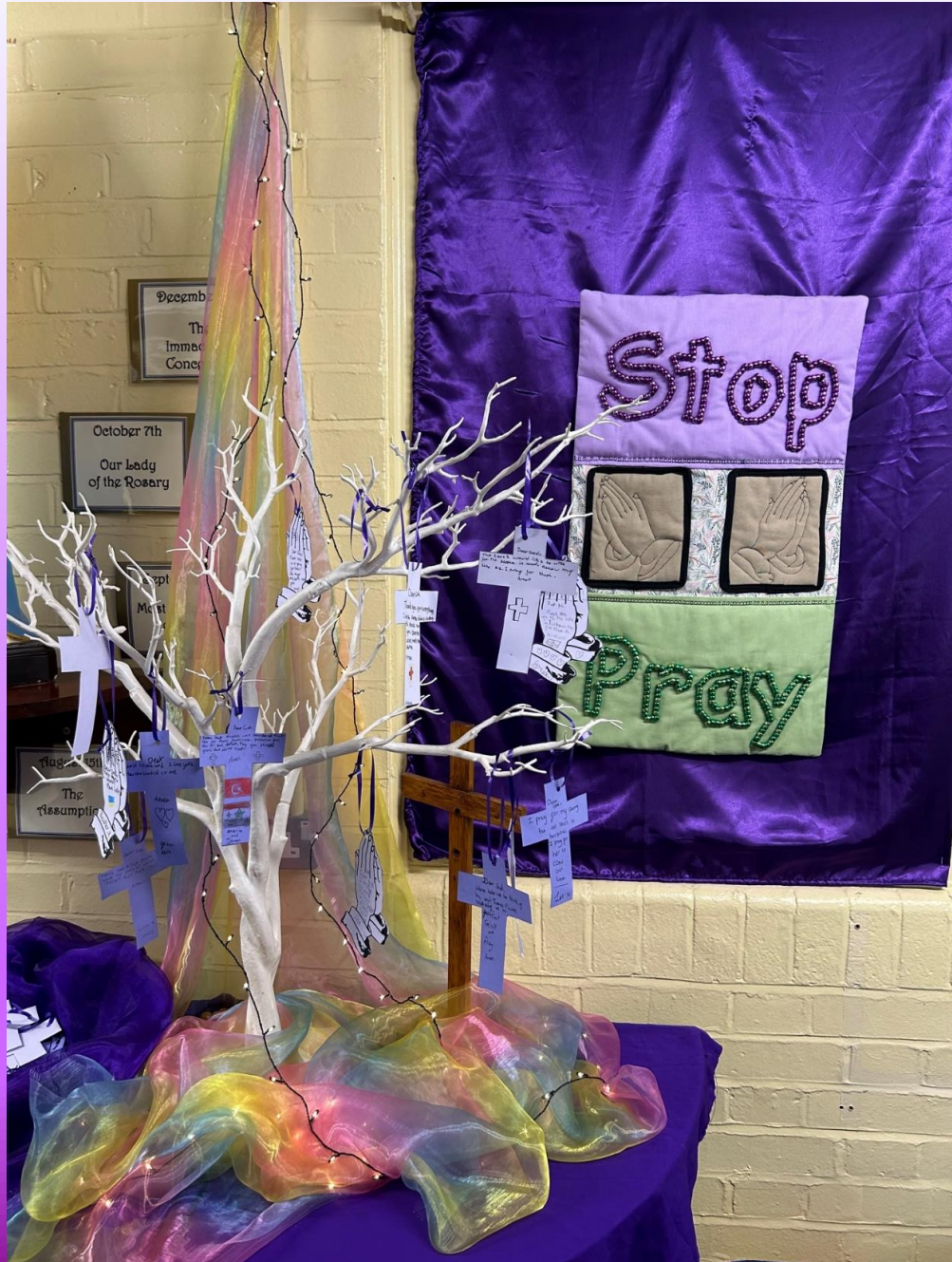
# More Lenten promises
